- **Movement building**, including community organising, team building, facilitation, networking.
- **Media and campaigning**, including campaigns, communications strategy, events organising.
- **Fundraising** and project management.
- **Policy and advocacy**, including designing strategies for engagement with key actors at national and regional levels.
- **Strategic litigation**, including strategies on going to court using European courts and international human rights law.
