Join us for the ninth TGEU European and Central Asian Trans Council from 21-24 November 2024, at [Salini Resort Hotel](#), Malta. Every two years, we bring together 200 trans activists from across Europe and Central Asia to set the agenda for trans politics and celebrate trans communities.

Together: Uniting in Solidarity and Resistance

This year's theme is *"Together: Uniting in Solidarity and Resistance,"* highlighting the importance of coming together to address the pressing issues facing trans communities in Europe and Central Asia.

In a world marked by crises and increasing threats to trans rights, it is more important than ever to stand side by side in solidarity and resistance. The Council will provide a space for trans advocates, policymakers, allies, and donors to come together, share ideas, and amplify voices in the fight for trans rights and equality.

Hosted by MGRM – The Malta LGBTIQ Rights Movement in collaboration with TGEU, the Council will bring together 200 participants from the region to engage in dialogue, mobilisation, and community-building. This is a unique opportunity to connect with fellow activists, learn from each other, and strategise for a stronger, more united trans movement.

Scholarships

All our members should have the opportunity to join us at this important gathering of the European and Central Asian trans community. Therefore, we're pleased to announce that we have secured funding for a limited number of full scholarships for activists to attend the Council. Partial scholarships are also available.

Strong preference will be given to TGEU members (group and individual members) and/or to trans and queer people from underrepresented groups and countries.

We especially encourage trans people from further marginalised backgrounds to apply, including Black people and people of colour, D/deaf and disabled people, people with a migration background, sex workers, trans women and gender-non-conforming people, people living with HIV, and people from Eastern Europe and Central Asia.

Volunteer

Frequently Asked Questions

I am not a member. Can I still register?

While the Council is focussed on our members, we do welcome a limited number of activists who are not (yet) part of TGEU. You can still register for the Council, and simply let us know via the form.

How much does it cost to register for the Council?

The cost of registration for the Council is 200€. This fee includes access to all sessions and meals provided during the event.

How much does accommodation cost and how can I book?

The prices for all accommodation options at the Salini Resort Hotel can be found in the registration form. Prices range from 75€ to 110€ depending on the room size.

Participants can book their own accommodation via the [hotel's website](#) (early booking discount code applies until 31 July). Wheelchair accessible rooms are available and can only be booked through TGEU by contacting us at council@tgeu.org

I'm worried about COVID-19 and other infections. What measures will be in place?

We're currently working on a health precautions plan with key measures to protect participants. This plan will be shared with all participants and potential participants ahead of the Council.

I applied for a scholarship. What happens if I don't get one?

We have full and partial scholarships available for a limited number of participants.

Our Board will review all scholarship applications carefully according to multiple criteria and your application will be given serious consideration.

However, we anticipate that there will be more applications than the number of scholarships we can grant. Alternatively, you may want to consider applying to become a volunteer. While we aren't able to cover the travel and accommodation costs for volunteers, we will waive your registration fees.

I have accessibility needs. How will my needs be taken care of?

We are planning on covering a wide range of needs: step-free venue, wheelchair accessible venue, and rooms, diverse dietary needs, a quiet room, an access team, live-captioning

In the registration form, you will be invited to share your access needs. We can't guarantee that we'll be able to accommodate them all, but will try our best to accommodate the needs indicated in this registration form. Please state your needs when required and we will clearly communicate the support we will be able to provide in advance so that you can organise your stay at the Council.

If you have any concerns or questions, please [contact us via email](#). Our team, supported by a Disability Advisor, will be happy to listen to your needs and talk through any concerns or questions with you to help you attend as fully as possible.

I need to get a visa. Can TGEU support me?

Yes, we will! TGEU will provide letters of invitation and support participants throughout the visa process. If you need a visa, please register for the Council by July at the latest. If you're unsure about whether you need a visa to travel to Malta and in the Schengen Area, please [check here](#).

Please keep in mind that it's your responsibility to obtain a visa. You will receive a letter of invitation to the Council once your registration and payment have been processed.
